PROJECT UPDATE: Veterans Parkway Road Improvements in Clarksville

CLARKSVILLE, IN – (October 5, 2017) – In 2016, the Town of Clarksville made application for and was awarded \$1.0 million dollars through the Indiana Department of Transportation – Community Crossing Grant Program. The project includes the resurfacing of Veterans Parkway and Green Tree Boulevard. To reduce traffic complications, the majority of the work is being completed at night. As the project progresses, the Town of Clarksville is providing updates our residents and visitors. The project will be completed prior to the busy Holiday Shopping Season.

Currently Underway:

- Milling and paving of Veteran’s Parkway and Green Tree Blvd should be complete by Monday, October 9.
- Pavement striping of Veteran’s Parkway and Green Tree Blvd should begin October 9.
- Pavement stamping and colorization of crosswalks at the intersections along of Veteran’s Parkway and Green Tree Blvd began October 4. This process will be applied to 5 intersections and result in one traffic lane closure in each direction. This work is expected to be complete in early November, weather permitting.
- Work continues on the westbound right turn lane from Veteran’s Parkway onto Lombardy Drive with anticipated paving being complete by October 19.
- Construction continues to progress on the entrances into the new Veteran’s Crossing development, located between Sam Gwin Drive and Green Tree North on Veterans Parkway.

Upcoming Project:

- New traffic lights will be installed at the intersection of Sam Gwin and Veteran's Parkway. In addition, utility work required for the Veteran's Crossing development will necessitate the closure of Sam Gwin for 1-2 days. An exact date has not yet been determined. A public notice of closure will be provided 48 hours in advance of closure.

These road projects will leave a lasting positive impact on our community. The Town of Clarksville will continue to minimize the impact of these projects on traffic. We appreciate our residents’ patience and understanding as we continue to make Clarksville an even better place to live, work, shop and invest.
