

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON AUGUST 3rd 2009

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on August 3, 2009, at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Greg Isgrigg, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Greg Isgrigg, Paul Kraft, Vicki Appleby, Raymond Richert, Donald Tetley, David Fisher and Bob Popp. Council members absent: None. Also present at the meeting: Fire Chief Robert Hansford, Police Chief Dwight Ingle, Town Engineer Tom Clevidence, Mike Otto representing the Town's wastewater treatment facility management firm, Redevelopment Director Richard Dickman, Planning Consultant Sharon Wilson, Parks Superintendent Brian Kaluzny, Building Inspector Bob Polston, Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon, and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Anita Elliott/Neeld.

Approval of Minutes... A motion was made by Council Member Kraft to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of the council held on July 20, 2009. The motion was seconded by Council Member Appleby and carried by unanimous vote,

Adoption of Ordinance 2009-S-09 Amending Ordinance 2009-S-01... Following the presentation of a proposed ordinance by Town Attorney Sturgeon numbered 2009-S-09 amending ordinance 2009-S-01 which adds the position of two Code Enforcement Officers in the Building and Planning Department, a motion was made by Council Member Fisher to consider ordinance 2009-S-09 for adoption on its first reading at this meeting.. The motion was seconded by Council Member Appleby and carried by unanimous vote. A motion was made by council Member Fisher to adopt Ordinance 2009-S-09. The motion was seconded by Council Member Appleby and carried by unanimous vote.

Miscellaneous Business... Town Engineer reported on the rain event that occurred last Thursday July 30, 2009. He reported that the Town received 2.5 inches in less than a half hour which caused some street flooring and had no complaints for homeowners with problems.

Council Comments... Council Member Fisher expressed his thanks to Sharon Wilson and Phyllis Pooler for their efforts in preparing the grant application for the COPS grant program. Council Member Tetley reported that there are some illegal benches on Lewis and Clarks Blvd @ Hale Rd. and asked Building Inspector Polston to check on them. Council Member Kraft reported that a citizen had called him with a complaint on the manhole covers on Eastern Blvd. It was determined that if there were any more complaints for them to be advised to call Town Attorney Sturgeon.

Approval of Claims... Accounts payable registers presented for approval consisted of Town pre-approved claims issued 7/27/09 through 8/3/09 in the amount of \$107,585.52, Town and Wastewater utility gross payroll issued 7/31/09 in the amount of \$310,048.61, Town current claims in the amount of \$68,049.12, Wastewater utility pre-approved claims issued 7/17/09 through 7/30/09 in the amount of \$23,453.83 and Wastewater utility current claims in the amount of \$110,741.21. A motion was made by Council member Kraft to approve the accounts payable registers presented. The motion was seconded by Council member Appleby and carried by unanimous vote.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council member Appleby, seconded by Council Member Kraft and carried by unanimous vote, the August 3, 2009 meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was adjourned at 7:12 P..M.
