

**MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF

Jorge Lanz with Jacobi, Toomz, and Lanz Consulting Engineers talked about the Stormwater Master Plan that had been done, but the cost was \$16 million and that the Town does not have the money but is seeking state assistance. He then asked for permission from the Council to go out and re-evaluate the different areas and possibly come back with a new schedule on the plan.
