

**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON SEPTEMBER 21st, 2009**

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on September 21, 2009, at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Greg Isgrigg, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Greg Isgrigg, Paul Kraft, Vicki Appleby, Raymond Richert, Donald Tetley, David Fisher and Bob Popp. Council members absent: None. Also present at the meeting: Assistant Fire Chief Brent Wilson, Police Chief Dwight Ingle, Street Commissioner Donnie Hansford, Mike Otto representing the Town's wastewater treatment facility management firm, Redevelopment Director Richard Dickman, Planning Consultant Sharon Wilson, Parks Superintendent Brian Kaluzny, Code Enforcement Officer Jeff Spainhour, Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon, Administrative Assistant Patricia Frasier, Clerk-Treasurer Gary Hall and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Anita Elliott/Neeld.

Approval of Minutes... A motion was made by Council Member Kraft to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of the council held on September 8, 2009 with correcting the section referring to purchase agreement being changed to Mrs. Farabee and not Mr. and Mrs. The motion was seconded by Council Member Popp and carried by unanimous vote.

Proclamation... Council President Isgrigg proclaimed that the month of October 2009 is Down Syndrome Awareness Month.

Departmental Reports... Assistant Fire Chief Wilson reported that the new aerial ladder fire truck arrived today and that training has already begun.

Planning Director Sharon Wilson announced that Brittany Montgomery from her office was present and available to take names of citizens that were affected by the last rain storm that occurred on September 20, 2009.

Council Comments... Council Member Popp reported that several areas in Town were affected by the last rain storm on September 20, 2009 naming Bells Lane, Maple Court, Beechwood Manor and Lincoln Heights. Council Member Popp requested that Engineer Tom Clevidence, Planning Consultant Sharon Wilson, Redevelopment Director Rick Dickman, Code Enforcement Officer Jeff Spainhour and Brittany Montgomery form a committee to obtain information from state or federal agencies on assisting town citizens who were affected by the recent rain storm. Council Member Popp asked Town Attorney Sturgeon if the Town could ticket individuals that crossed barricade lines that the town put up to prevent entering certain areas. Town Attorney Sturgeon reported that an ordinance would need to be written. Council President Isgrigg reported that the Town had previously performed studies on water problems throughout the Town and he feels that a plan needs to be initiated. Council President Isgrigg also reported that the Town has applied for state funding to help out with some of the water problems within the Town. Council Member Popp requested that the Stormwater Department prepare monthly reports showing the work that is being done throughout the Town.

Citizens Comments...Angela Smith and Becky Wadsworth representing Cannon's Florist came before the Council expressing their concerns with the recent rain storm that left 2 ½ feet of water in their basement and 4 feet from the rain storm that hit four weeks earlier. They expressed that the Town needs to address problems with the storm drains that are located near their Florist. Mr. John Gilkey from Accrusia Avenue came before the Council also with flooring concerns that caused sewage back up in his basement.

Approval of Claims... Accounts payable registers presented for approval consisted of Town pre-approved claims issued 9/10/09 through 9/21/09 in the amount of \$365,586.39, Town and Wastewater utility gross payroll issued 9/11/09 in the amount of \$365,218.70, Town current claims in the amount of \$83,637.45, Wastewater/Stormwater utility pre-approved claims issued 9/8/09 through 9/17/09 in the amount of \$863,502.25, and Wastewater/Stormwater utility current claims in the amount of \$195,103.35. A motion was made by Council member Kraft to approve the accounts payable registers presented. The motion was seconded by Council member Appleby and carried by unanimous vote.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Kraft, seconded by Council Member Appleby and carried by unanimous vote, the September 21, 2009 meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was adjourned at 7:30 P..M.
