

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON JULY 6, 2010**

A special meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on the 6th day of July 2010, at 6:30 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Gregory Isgrigg

Council members present: Greg Isgrigg, Paul Kraft, Raymond Richert, Donald Tetley, Vicki Appleby, David Fisher and Bob Popp. Council members absent: None. Also present at the meeting: Town Attorney Rebecca Lockard, Planning Director Sharon Wilson, Code Enforcement Officer Fred Hall, Grant Writer Brittany Montgomery, Dale Cox an outside Licensed Electrician, Clerk Treasurer Gary Hall and Natalie McLochlin.

Chairman Isgrigg announced that this special meeting was being held for a hearing regarding suspension or revocation of a contractor's license. Council member Popp noted that Interim Building Inspector Spainhour was not present for this special meeting. Council member Fisher informed Council member Popp that Code Enforcement Officer Fred Hall was more informed on this matter.

Code Enforcement Officer Fred Hall and Town Attorney Rebecca Lockard presented to the Council safety issues that had been found at two different residences in the Town of Clarksville during routine contractor inspections and complaints from the residents. Code Enforcement Officer Hall presented electrical inspection photographs of Martin Pelayo's work that was completed at the residence of Patsy Leach 1704 Idlewood Drive, and Nick Bickler 139 E. Harrison Ave that showed fire and safety hazards in the work that was completed. Town Attorney Lockard and Code Enforcement Officer Hall were asking that the Council revoke Martin Pelayo's contractor's license immediately. Council member Popp then asked Mr. Dale Cox the outside licensed electrician if he thought the license needed to be revoked. Mr. Cox agreed that what Code Enforcement Officer Hall found in these inspections are fire and safety hazards and that Mr. Pelayo's license should be revoked.

Following further discussion a motion was made by Council member Tetley to revoke Mr. Martin Pelayo's contractor's license effective immediately. The motion was seconded by Council member Kraft and carried by unanimous vote.

There being no further business to come before the council at this time the special meeting was duly adjourned at 7:06 P.M.
