

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF  
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL  
HELD ON JULY 19, 2010

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on July 19, 2010 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Gregory Isgrigg, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Gregory Isgrigg, Paul Kraft, Vicki Appleby, Raymond Richert, Donald Tetley, David Fisher and Bob Popp. Council members absent: None. Also present at the meeting: Assistant Fire Chief Thomas Upton, Police Chief Dwight Ingle, Assistant Police Chief Dale Abell, Street Commissioner Donnie Hansford, Director of Engineering & Stormwater Tom Clevidence, Mike Otto representing the Town's wastewater treatment facility management firm, Redevelopment Director Richard Dickman, Planning Consultant Sharon Wilson, Grant Writer Brittany Montgomery, Parks Superintendent Brian Kaluzny, Code Enforcement Officer Jeff Spainhour, Council Administrative Assistant Trish Fraser, Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon, Clerk-Treasurer Gary Hall, and Natalie McLochlin.

**Approval of Minutes**... A motion was made by Council member Kraft to approve the minutes of the work session of the council held on June 21, 2010. The motion was seconded by Council member Fisher and carried by unanimous vote. A motion was made by Council member Kraft to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of the council held on June 21, 2010. The motion was seconded by Council member Fisher and carried by unanimous vote.

**Presentation of Award**... Council President Isgrigg called Police Chief Dwight Ingle, Assistant Police Chief Abell and reserve officer Chris Kraft forward to present the award. Police Chief Dwight Ingle then presented an award to Bob Kraft for his 30 years of dedicated service to the reserve department.

**Approval of Disclosures**... Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon presented to the Council disclosures for Town employees David Wood and Gary Barnes for their contracted grass cutting services. Following further discussion a motion was made by Council member Tetley to approve the disclosure from David Wood for contracted grass cutting services. The motion was seconded by Council member Kraft and carried by unanimous vote. A motion was made by Council member Fisher to approve the disclosure from Gary Barnes for contracted grass cutting services. The motion was seconded by Council member Kraft and carried by unanimous vote.

**Notice of Resignation**... Council President Isgrigg noted that he received a letter of resignation from Gil Campbell, stating that he was resigning from the Greenway Commission.

**Adoption of Ordinance 2010-ST-01**... Following the presentation of a proposed Ordinance by Town Attorney Sturgeon numbered 2010-ST-01, repealing 2008-ST-01 and restoring the speed limit on Eastern Boulevard, a motion was made by Council member Tetley to consider Ordinance 2010-ST-01 for adoption on its first reading at this meeting. The motion was seconded by Council member Popp and carried by unanimous vote. A motion was made by Council member Tetley to adopt Ordinance 2010-ST-01. The motion was seconded by Council member Popp and carried by unanimous vote.

**Adoption of Ordinance 2010-G-02**... Following the presentation of proposed Ordinance by Town Attorney Sturgeon numbered 2010-G-02, amending ordinance 94-G-03 regarding collection for removing grass, weeds, and rank vegetation, a motion was made by Council member Richert to consider Ordinance 2010-G-02 for adoption on its first reading at this meeting. The motion was seconded by Council member Kraft and carried by unanimous vote. A motion was made by Council member Richert to adopt Ordinance 2010-G-02. The motion was seconded by Council member Kraft and carried by unanimous vote.

**Adoption of Ordinance 2010-BUD-03**... Following the presentation of proposed Ordinance by Town Attorney Sturgeon numbered 2010-BUD-03, transferring monies between major categories in Fire Pension and Town Garage, a motion was made by Council member

Kraft to consider Ordinance 2010-BUD-03 for adopting on its first reading at this meeting. The motion was seconded by Council member Popp and carried by unanimous vote. A motion was made by Council member Kraft to adopt Ordinance 2010-BUD-03. The motion was seconded by Council member Popp and carried by unanimous vote.

**Approval for sale of items at the Street Department...** Town Attorney Sturgeon presented a list to the Council consisting of items the Street Department was requesting for approval to sell. The list consisted of Garbage Truck #26, Dump Truck #19, Pick-up Truck #15, one roller, two fuel tanks, and one spray machine. Sturgeon also noted that some of these items were causing environmental hazards and were in need of repair and needed to be removed before inspection by the Department of Environmental Management (IDEM). Sturgeon presented the list of bidders to the council consisting of Goodman Construction in the amount of \$4,250.00, Wheeler's in the amount of \$3,865.00, Marshall's in the amount of \$3,700.00 and Bennett's Towing and Recovery in the amount of \$2,075.00, recommending selling to Goodman Construction because they had the highest offer. Following further discussion a motion was made by Council member Richert to approve the sale of these items to Goodman Construction in the amount of \$4,250.00. The motion was seconded by Council member Kraft and carried by unanimous vote.

**Department Reports...** Council Administrative Assistant Trish Fraser wanted to announce to all Department Heads that if they had an employee who is a business owner or they are doing business with the Town of Clarksville, that they needed to make sure the employee is to fill out the disclosure form for the Council to approve.

Trish also explained to the Council that she had received several phone calls from residents on Evergreen Drive stating the street sign had been changed to Evergreen Street during the renovation to Eastern Blvd. and wanted to ask the Council if they would change it back to Evergreen Drive. Town Attorney Sturgeon advised that he would write up an ordinance to change the street name back.

**Council Comments...** Council member Fisher wanted to thank Jeff Spainhour and Sharon Wilson for the job they have been doing with the grass cuttings. Fisher also acknowledged Mr. Kraft for his dedicated service.

Council member Popp made an announcement that Wednesday September 8<sup>th</sup> 2010 at 6:30 p.m. was going to be the premiere showing of the prison documentary, with the place to still be determined. He also noted that everyone was invited and there was no charge.

Council member Popp also wanted to acknowledge Brian Kaluzny for being profiled in the Sunnyside Times for his 17 years of dedicated service to the Clarksville Parks and Recreation.

Council President Isgrigg asked Brittany Montgomery to come forward to speak to the Council. Brittany asked the Council to think of any intersections in the Town that were very dangerous so there could be a list sent to KIPDA, because they are working on a way to receive financial assistance to better these intersections.

Council member Paul Kraft wanted to thank the Street Department for cleaning up all of the weeds on L&C Parkway and Brown Station Way.

Council President Isgrigg expressed appreciation to Chris Kraft for taking the lead of the Police reserve department.

**Approval of Claims...** Accounts payable registers presented for approval consisted of Town pre-approved claims issued 7/6/2010 through 7/19/2010 in the amount of \$472,589.14, Town current claims in the amount of \$2,022,781.07, Town and Wastewater/Stormwater utility gross payroll issued in the amount of \$307,490.29, Wastewater/Stormwater utility pre-approved claims issued 7/06/2010 through 7/12/2010 in the amount of \$8,804.45, Wastewater/Stormwater utility pre-approved claims issued 7/15/2010 in the amount of \$20,174.01, Wastewater/Stormwater utility pre-approved claims issued 7/7/2010 in the amount of \$1,370.00 and Wastewater/Stormwater utility current claims in the amount of \$157,989.68. A motion was made by Council Member Kraft to approve the accounts payable registers presented. The motion was seconded by Council Member Appleby and carried by unanimous vote.

**Adjournment**... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Fisher, seconded by Council Member Popp and carried by unanimous vote, the July 19, 2010 meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was adjourned at 7:34 P..M.
