

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON NOVEMBER 22, 2010**

A special meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was held as advertised on the 22nd day of November, 2010, at 7:00 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building.

Council members present: Gregory Isgrigg, Raymond Richert, Don Tetley, Bob Popp, David Fisher, Vicki Appleby and Paul Kraft. Council members absent: None. Also present at the meeting: Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon, F.O.P. Lodge #144 representatives Joel DeMoss, David Kirby, Jason Tackett, and Steve Fryrear, F.O.P. Attorney Leo Blackwell, and Clerk-Treasurer Gary Hall.

Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon advised the FOP representatives that the Council had agreed to accept the last proposal made by the F.O.P at the previous negotiating session held on November 18, 2010, and provided F.O.P. representatives with a copy of the proposal signed as accepted by all council members.

F.O.P. Attorney Leo Blackwell stated that he had phoned Mr. Sturgeon prior to this meeting and told him that the F.O.P. wished to withdraw the proposal as written because the membership was not in agreement. Town Attorney Sturgeon stated that the acceptance of the F.O.P.'s last proposal was the final position of the Town, as it was offered by the F.O.P. and accepted by the Town Council in good faith.

F.O.P. Attorney Blackwell stated that the proposal would have to be taken to the full body of the F.O.P. membership to determine their official position and that he did not think they would approve it.

Town Attorney Sturgeon asked if the F.O.P. membership did not agree to their representatives' proposal which was accepted by the Town whether that was the final position of the F.O.P. as to the health insurance issue. F.O.P. Attorney Blackwell asked if the Town was through with negotiations if the F.O.P. majority declined the Town's acceptance of the last F.O.P. offer, stating that he did not want to make the trip from Indianapolis for another meeting if the Town is saying that it would not consider further negotiations. Mr. Blackwell explained that he feels the F.O.P. membership would rather have language in the contract that would actually have a cost factor as to what the membership would be required to pay in the future for health insurance.

After conferring with F.O.P. representative Joel DeMoss, F.O.P. Attorney Blackwell stated that the F.O.P. would let the Council know no later than next Wednesday as to whether the membership accepts or declines the Town's offer to accept the last F.O.P. proposal with the language referring to health insurance as it was written, and then the council members could determine if they wished to negotiate any further.

There being no further business at the time, the meeting was duly adjourned.
