

**MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON
FEBRUARY 6, 2012**

An advertised work session of the Clarksville Town Council and the Clarksville Community School Corporation Board of Trustees was called to order on February 6, 2012, at 9:15 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President John Gilkey.

Council members present: John Gilkey, Paul Kraft, Donald Tetley, Bob Popp and Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber and Bob Polston. Also present at the meeting: Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon, Financial Advisor Roberta McLemore, Chief Deputy Sherry Lockard and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Anita Elliott-Neeld.

Superintendent Kim Knott of Clarksville Community School Corporation came before the Council with information that she obtained on homeowners within the Town's taxing district. Ms. Knott explained that her information shows that some homeowners within the Town are receiving tax statements of zero dollars and that the closing of the Colgate plant is going to affect both the School Corporation and the Town. Council President Gilkey explained that the Council is reviewing a proposal from Umbaugh & Associates to do a study on taxation and spending within the Town and that the study will help determine what can be done to raise revenues.
