

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON
FEBRUARY 9, 2012

An advertised work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on February 9, 2012, at 7:00 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President John Gilkey.

Council members present: John Gilkey, Paul Kraft, Donald Tetley, Bob Popp, Tim Hauber and Bob Polston. Council Member Fetter walked in at 7:20 P.M. Also present at the meeting: Financial Advisor Roberta McLemore, Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon, and Deputy Clerk Treasurer Anita Elliott-Neeld.

Representatives from the Kentuckiana Medical Center returned to the Council with the final plea to the Town on financial assistance in keeping the Medical Center opened. Town Attorney Rebecca Lockard advised that if the Town would commit to the financial assistance it could possibly limit the Town's ability to get funding in the future. Following discussion, Council Member Popp stated that the Town is not rejecting this matter but acknowledging that the Town is not in the financial position to bail out the Kentuckiana Medical Center and therefore no motion was made.

Council Member Popp reminded the Council Members and any of the Department Heads at this meeting to complete their requested capital improvement projects list and present it to the Redevelopment Director Rick Dickman.
