

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF  
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON  
JULY 16, 2012

An advertised work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on July 16, 2012, at 8:34 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President John Gilkey.

Council members present: John Gilkey, Paul Kraft, Donald Tetley, Tim Hauber, Paul Fetter, Bob Popp and Bob Polston. Council Members Absent: None. Also present at the meeting Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon, Clerk Treasurer Robert Leuthart, Administrative Assistant of Finance Roberta McLemore, Administrative Assistant Patricia Fraser, Planning Director Sharon Wilson, Street Commissioner Brad Cummings, Project Coordinator Brittany Montgomery, Chief of Police Mark Palmer, Harold Hart and Chief Deputy Clerk Treasurer Sherry Lockard.

**Redistricting...** Administrative Assistant Patricia Fraser advised Council that the process of redistricting needs to begin as required by State Statute. Discussion was held regarding the matter of voting by district or by voting at large. Also discussed was the matter of uneven population in districts. No votes were taken on any matters regarding redistricting at this time.

**Resident Parking Only Permits...** Council President John Gilkey suggested a need to review the process in which Resident Parking Only permits were done. After discussion, it was decided that Harold Hart, Sharon Wilson, Brad Cummings and Trish Fraser were to prepare a recommendation for the Council regarding the Resident Parking Only permits.

**Paving Bids...** Street Commissioner Brad Cummings and Harold Hart presented the paving bids to the Council. After discussion, it was decided that Street Commissioner Brad Cummings brings each individual project to the Council for approval of each separate job and paving contract.

**Council President Comments...** Council President John Gilkey advised there was a sewer collapse involving approximately 300 feet of pipe and that Project Coordinator Brittany Montgomery is checking on this. He suggested the Town needs to think about keeping funds on hand for this type of repairs. Regarding the recent flood in the Town Hall, Mr. Gilkey advised to keep Culpepper Cooper updated on any claims that need to be made.

**Adjournment...** There being no further business to come before the Council at this work session, the meeting was adjourned at 9:43 P.M.
