

**MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON
AUGUST 6, 2012**

An advertised work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on August 6, 2012, at 8:00 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President John Gilkey.

Council members present: John Gilkey, Paul Kraft, Donald Tetley, Bob Popp, Tim Hauber, Paul Fetter and Bob Polston. Council Members Absent: None. Also present at the meeting Town Attorney Rebecca Lockard, Planning Director Sharon Wilson, Director of Engineering/Stormwater Tom Clevidence, Street Commissioner Brad Cummings, Redevelopment Director Rick Dickman, Financial Advisor Roberta McLemore, Administrative Assistant Trish Frasier, Parks Superintendent Brian Kaluzny, President of Eastern Boulevard Association Doug Fisher and Deputy Clerk Treasurer Anita Elliott-Neeld.

Deer Run Park Infrastructure... Director of Engineering/Stormwater Tom Clevidence reported on the Deer Run Park infrastructure completion. Mr. Clevidence reported that the subdivision has been completed for several years but has never been accepted by the Town. The contractors that build the subdivision years ago are no longer in business and the subdivision is not up to ADA standards and several infrastructure repairs need to be completed. Town Attorney Rebecca Lockard reported that the Town Council will need to accept the subdivision in order for repairs to be done. Following discussion it was determined that this item will be discussed at the next regular scheduled meeting of the council.

Eastern Boulevard Master Plan... Representatives from The Corradino Group presented a Revitalization Plan for Eastern Boulevard with funding that the Town received from a grant and funding from TIF. Discussion was held on how to improve and revitalize Eastern Boulevard while bringing new businesses and residents to the area. A meeting is scheduled for public input on August 9th at 7:00 at the Clarksville Town Hall.

Police Chief Mark Palmer Consideration for Additional Officer... Police Chief Mark Palmer came before the council reporting that he and Dr. Kim Knott of Clarksville Community School are requesting that a full time police officer be available in the schools from the time school starts and until the school day ends. Chief Palmer asked if the Council would consider hiring this officer and paying 50% of the salary with the school system paying the other 50%.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this work session, the meeting was adjourned at 9:28 P.M.
