<u>Discussion of Wastewater and Stormwater Rates...</u> Representatives from H. J Umbaugh & Associates Certified Public Accountants presented information in reference to the Town's current financial situation. Discussion was held on the current appeals that are currently being examined to determine if any additional revenues will be generated toward next year's tax collections. Following discussion on the rate increase in the WW/SW utility it was the consensus of those present to have only one rate increase.

<u>Discussion on Remunicipalization of Wastewater Plant</u>... Discussion was held on the possibility of the Town taking over the operation of the Wastewater Treatment Plant. The Town can elect not to renew the contract with American Water Company and to retain the employees to operate the plant at a cost savings to the Town. Following discussion it was the consensus of those present to move forward with the remunicipalization of the wastewater treatment utility.

<u>Discussion Regarding Colgate Property</u>... Discussion was held by Council and Dr. Jayesh Sheth regarding the wastewater and sewer liens on the Colgate Property. No decisions were made.
