

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE  
CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on June 17, 2013, at 8:20 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Bob Polston who chaired the meeting.

Also present at the meeting: Clerk Treasurer Robert Leuthart, Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon, Police Chief Mark Palmer, Director of Stormwater Tom Clevidence, Administrative Assistant Patricia Fraser, Street Commissioner Brad Cummings, Planning Consultant Sharon Wilson, Building Commissioner Ipo Majuri, Redevelopment Director Nick Lawrence, Parks Superintendent Brian Kaluzny, and Deputy Clerk Treasurer Sherry Lockard.

**Discussion of salary increases for non contract employees...** The Office of the Clerk Treasurer presented two proposals for salary increases for non contract employees. Proposal #1 was based on an equal flat percentage rate and Proposal #2 was based on a percentage rate defined by years of service. The Clerk Treasurer's Office is recommending the proposal with the percentage rate based on years of service. Discussion was held regarding the two proposals and a general consensus of the council members was to accept the percentage proposal based on years of service. No vote was taken at this time. Proposal to be presented at the next regularly scheduled council meeting.
