

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE
TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON MAY 2, 2017

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on May 2, 2017 at 7:40 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Jennifer Voignier, and Aaron Stonecipher. Absent: Tim

Presentation and Discussion on Street Addressing by the Planning Department... Planning Director addressed the Council and stated that the process of addressing a property has been done by the Planning Department since its inception. The main reason for the specifics of addressing a property is for safety reasons, so that emergency vehicles can locate the address in an emergency situation.

Attorney Greg Fifer added that the Town is also held accountable for this under certain Indiana Codes, in that each political subdivision shall assign and restructure numbers per State Legislation. Mr. Fifer stated if a property owner wanted to change their address, then there is a process that must be followed, which begins with an appeal that is done at the staff level of the Planning Department, and then the BZA can be asked to review the appeal.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, Council Member Worrall made a motion to adjourn, Council Member Voignier seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote, 5-0. The meeting was adjourned at 8:04 P.M.
