

**MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE
TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON OCTOBER 3, 2017**

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on October 3, 2017 at 7:58 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber, John Gilkey, David Worrall, and Jennifer Voignier. Absent David Fisher and Aaron Stonecipher.

Discussion of Creating a Detective Rank within the Police Department... Chief Palmer came before the Council to request a soft, floating rank or Corporal within the Detective Division. The annual cost for this request will be \$5300.00 and there will be 3 floating spots, with the plan to use two and leave one to use when someone is out with an injury or illness. Discussion was held and Chief Palmer was advised to bring to next Council meeting for a vote.

Discussion of Purchase of a new K-9 for the Police Department... Chief Palmer came before the Council and advised since the retirement of Officer Beyerle and K-9 Kilo, the department is requesting a new K-9. Chief Palmer advised Officer Matt Bauer will be the K-9 handler and that the purchase of the dog can come from the Police Drug Fund, (money confiscated from drug related arrests), and not use taxpayer money. Chief Palmer advised the cost of the K-9 would be \$13,098.00 and that money is available in the drug fund. Chief Palmer was advised to bring the matter to the next Council meeting for a vote.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, Council Member Worrall made a motion to adjourn, Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by 5-0 vote. The meeting was adjourned at 8:16 P.M.
