

**MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on January 16, 2018 at 8:25 P.M. in the Council Chambers of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter who chaired the meeting.

**Proposal and Discussion of ClarkFest...**

Board Members from the ClarkFest came before the Council and advised due to liability, the board would no longer be able to operate as it has been and they are in the process of dissolving the Board. They expressed their interest in continuing with ClarkFest, but only in a participation capacity and requested the Town to make it a Town Event. Discussion was held regarding insurance and costs. The consensus of the Council was to make this a Town Event pending further information received. No action taken at this time.

**Review and Discussion of Pedestrian Bridge, McCulloch Pike Bridge and Brown Station Way...**

Staff came before Council to discuss the needs of each of these bridges and staff suggested a corridor study with focal points. Discussion was held and it was recommended that Staff bring a proposal to the next Council meeting regarding replacing the pedestrian bridge and a corridor study. No action taken at this time.

**Adjournment...** There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Voignier, seconded by Council Member Gilkey, and carried by 6-0 vote, the January 16, 2018 work session of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 9:54 p.m.
