

**MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE
TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON APRIL 17, 2018**

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on April 3, 2018 at 7:55 P.M. in the Executive Conference Room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber, David Worrall, David Fisher, Jennifer Voignier, John Gilkey, and Aaron Stonecipher.

Discussion regarding Progress Way Apartments

Discussion held regarding the economic impact of a new apartment complex. After further discussion it was decided more information was needed but the planning process was going to continue with all necessary departments. No action taken at this time.

Discussion of adding a School Resource Officer (SRO) at Parkwood School

Chief Mark Palmer presented a request from the Greater Clark School Corp for an SRO at Parkwood School. After further discussion, it was decided that Chief Palmer would negotiate further with GCSC and Council advised to bring a new proposal to the next Council Meeting.

Discussion of Fire Lane Amendments and False Fire Alarm Fees

Discussion was held regarding Fire Lane, and False Alarm ordinances. After further discussion it was decided to have Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon assist in writing ordinances with broader enforcement, to include Handicap Parking issues. Council advised to bring new ordinance for review in a future session.

Discussion of Renaming of Green Tree Blvd and Green Tree North

Presentation by Redevelopment Director Dylan Fisher regarding impact and process involved with renaming Green Tree Blvd and Green Tree North. Discussion was held and it was advised to move forward with developing the process and bring back for further discussion.

Discussion of adding a Farmers Market Feature

Discussion initiated by Council Member Voignier about the potential for a Farmers Market feature to be added to the Town of Clarksville. The Parks Department has discussed this previously. Staff will review and determine if there is interest from area produce farmers.

July 4th Concert spending Increase

Discussion initiated by Council Member Gilkey, who requested additional funding of \$1700.00 for a total of \$5,000.00 to cover expenses involved. Council members agreed additional funding is needed and directed staff to verify fund availability and bring the matter back for Council consideration.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Hauber, seconded by Council Member Voignier, and carried by 7-0 vote, the April 17, 2018 work session of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 9:55 p.m.
