Project Fact Sheet

Project: Owens Way Roadway and Gateway Crossing Subdivision

Description: The project consisted of constructing over 1,000 linear feet of new roadway through the former Peddlers' Mall Site, connecting Eastern Boulevard to Little League Boulevard. The existing parking lot was in poor condition, and as such was removed and replaced with a new, full depth asphalt roadway, complete with concrete curb & gutter, sidewalk, lighting, landscaping and storm sewer improvements. The project was successful in creating an improved corridor for vehicle and pedestrian access to the development, as well as provides an additional connection between Eastern Boulevard and Gateway and Little League Park. In addition to the new road, a traffic signal was installed at the intersection with Little League Boulevard. A new sidewalk was constructed along Little League Boulevard to complete the pedestrian access to the adjacent subdivision.
