

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON
JANUARY 06, 2014

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on January 06, 2014, at 7:46 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Bob Polston who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: John Gilkey, Paul Kraft, Donald Tetley, Bob Popp, Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber, and Bob Polston. Also present at the meeting: Clerk Treasurer Robert Leuthart, Town Attorney Rebecca Lockard, Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon, Parks Superintendent Brian Kaluzny, Phyllis Pooler, GIS of Planning and Development, Redevelopment Director Nick Lawrence, Fire Chief Tom Upton, Chief of Police Mark Palmer, Project Coordinator Brittany Montgomery, Building Commissioner Iipo Majuri, Planning Consultant Sharon Wilson, and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Sherry Lockard.

LED SIGNS Presentation by Sharon Wilson... Ms. Wilson gave a presentation regarding the allowance of usage of LED signs within the Town of Clarksville. Ms. Wilson suggested that we not prohibit these types of signs completely, but allow them with strict regulations. Discussion was held regarding matters such as driver distraction, whether signs would be aesthetically pleasing, input from the business owners as well as the public, and the possibility of holding a public meeting before a public hearing was planned. Fire Truck Bid results by Fire Chief Tom Upton... Chief Upton advised advertising requirements were met and 6 bid packets were picked up for possible bids. However, only one bid was submitted by deadline. Chief Upton is recommending to the Council to reject that bid on the basis that we have no competitive pricing, and allow him to re-bid the project. Council Member Tetley made a motion to review the Specs and go back to the bid process and start again. Council Member Kraft seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.
