

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on February 19, 2013, at 7:40 P.M. in the Council Chambers the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Bob Polston who chaired the meeting.

Discussion was held on the revision to the On-Call policy with employees from the Street Department, Stormwater Department and the Wastewater Treatment Plant. A revised policy will be prepared and brought to a Council meeting for approval.

Discussion was held on the new police contract changing officers 8 hour shifts to 12 hour shifts.

Police Chief Palmer brought to the council information for a request to purchase safety equipment for the officers through the LOIT funding.

Council President Polston reported that the J.B. Ogle Animal Shelter is raising the annual fees and discussion was held with Street Commissioner Brad Cummings on the number of calls our animal control officer takes.
