

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON AUGUST 19, 2013

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on August 19, 2013, at 8:20 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Bob Polston who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Bob Polston, Paul Kraft, Donald Tetley, Bob Popp, Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber and John Gilkey. Council Members Absent: None. Also present at the meeting: Clerk Treasurer Robert Leuthart, Town Attorney Chris Sturgeon, Town Attorney Rebecca Lockard, Building Commissioner Ilpo Majuri, Project Coordinator Brittany Montgomery, Administrative Assistant Patricia Fraser, Street Commissioner Brad Cummings, Planning Consultant Sharon Wilson, Redevelopment Director Nick Lawrence, Police Chief Mark Palmer, and Deputy Clerk Treasurer Sherry Lockard.

Update from Project Coordinator on the I&I Program... Project Coordinator Brittany Montgomery advised that the I&I Program was entering into the next phase, which is smoke testing the Town lines only. This testing will begin at the end of August and notices will be sent out to residents. There is a possibility that the Code Red system will be used to announce the locations and dates of the smoke testing. Door hangers will also be posted to let residents know when and where the smoke testing will occur. The reason for the smoke testing is to look for cracks and cross connections. Also Ms. Montgomery advised the Fire Dept. would also be notified in case they start receiving calls from residents. Ms. Montgomery advised the smoke is harmless.

Update from Chief of Police Mark Palmer regarding the influx of homeless camps... Chief Palmer advised that there was a greater influx of homeless camps popping up in Clarksville due to the Bridge Project. Chief Palmer advised the police department is just trying to enforce the ordinance that is already in place and to handle the situation as delicately as possible, by contacting the outside agencies for their assistance in obtaining proper placement anyone that is in need of it.

-It was mentioned that if no one wanted the asphalt in front of Town Hall where the Vietnam Wall Replica was placed, then it will be removed and the grass will re-sodded. No one wanted the asphalt, so it will be removed.

-It was noted the One Southern Indiana Luncheon will be held on September 12, 2013 from 11:30-1:00 at Kye's. Contact Trish if you would like to attend.

-Attorney Sturgeon advised he had sent the 911 consolidation information to everyone and that it will need some consideration in the near future. Attorney Sturgeon is to prepare a brief overview of the consolidation packet.
