The Consent Agenda having been prepared and presented to the Council, Council Member Stonecipher raised a discussion with staff regarding the amending of fees for resident-only parking permits. Manager Baity agreed to a review of said fees. A motion was made by Council Member Stonecipher to approve the Consent Agenda. Council Member Voignier seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote.

Renewal of Contract for Mowing & Landscaping Services: Raymond's Lawn Care & Landscaping has been providing services for the Town for over 10 years. The contract has proven beneficial to the Town and eliminated the need for these services to be provided by municipal staff. The increase in work has been discussed and a revised contract has been presented for a period of two years and a renewal option of an additional 2 years at no additional costs. Council Member Voignier made a motion to approve the Renewal of Contract for Mowing & Landscaping Services with Raymond's Lawn Care & Landscaping. Council Member Worrall seconded the motion and it was carried by a 7-0 vote
