

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON FEBRUARY 19, 2019

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on February 19, 2019 at 8:13 P.M. in the Council Chambers of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Aaron Stonecipher, Jennifer Voignier and Jaime Hunt.

Discussion of Interlocal Agreement with Jeffersonville Township for Fire Protection Services

Manager Baity presented to the Council an agreement with Jeffersonville Township for Fire Protection in 2019 and 2020. The agreement is for a one-time payment to the Town in the amount of \$200,000.00. Manager Baity advised the second year of the contract would be null and void, provided the creation of the Fire Territory is successful and effective January 1, 2020. Discussion was held and Staff was advised to bring to the March 5th meeting for a vote.

Discussion of Revisions to Animal Control Contract

Discussion was held regarding the proposed Animal Control Contract. The fee amount paid to the JB Ogle Center did not change from the previous year, but a new provision was added regarding a "Spay and Release" program for feral cats. Further discussion was held and Staff was advised to bring the contract to the March 5th meeting for a vote.

Funding for Town Events

Discussion was held regarding funding for 2019 Town Events, including Memorial Day, ClarkFest, Veteran's Day and Independence Day. Discussion was held on the required amounts to fund each event and a request for Council involvement with ClarkFest. Council Member Jennifer Voignier volunteered to be the Chairperson for ClarkFest and Council Member Jaime Hunt volunteered to assist. Further discussion was held regarding the Lewis and Clark Handshake Event and the coordination of this event with ClarkFest. Council requested further information on the Lewis and Clark Handshake Event. Staff to bring information back to a work session.

Discussion of New Employee Handbook

Council was presented with the new and updated version of the Employee Handbook. Discussion was held, minor changes were suggested, and Staff is to bring it to the Council once changes have been made.

Town Employee Delinquent Sewer Bills

Discussion was held regarding Town employees with a delinquent sewer bill. Council advised to treat the employees as they would any other customer.

Adjournment.... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Worrall, seconded by Council Member Voignier, and carried by 7-0 vote, the February 19, 2019 work session of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 9:03 p.m.
