

MINUTES OF MEETING OF  
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL  
HELD ON MARCH 5, 2019

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on March 5, 2019 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Aaron Stonecipher, Jennifer Voignier, Tim Hauber and Jaime Hunt.

**Recognitions:**

-Proclamation - Girl Scouts Week proclaimed as March 10-16, 2019 in Clarksville, IN

-Proclamation – Rotary Day proclaimed as Saturday, April 27, 2019 in Clarksville, IN

**Consent Agenda:**

-Approval of Regular Town Council Meeting and Work and Executive Sessions held on February 19, 2019 and Special Public Hearing held on February 25, 2019.

-Approval of the Claims of Town Current & Pre-written, WW/SW Current & Pre-written. WW/SW Bonds, Payroll and Sewer Works Bans.

-Resolution 2019-R-07 Approving an Interlocal Agreement with Jeffersonville for Use of Animal Shelter.

-Approval of Purchase of a Heavy Duty Cab & Chassis for Public Works Department.

A motion was made by Council Member Voignier to approve the Consent Agenda. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote.

**Unfinished Business:** The resolution that was tabled at the February 19<sup>th</sup> meeting is no longer needed as an agreement was reached between parties.

**New Business:**

-Acceptance of Conflict of Interest Statements.

. A motion was made by Council Member Hauber to accept the Statements. Council Member Worrall seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote.

-Resolution 2019-R-08 Approving an Interlocal Agreement with Jeffersonville Township for Fire Protection Services. The new Agreement is for a 2 year period (2019-2020) and may terminate early with the creation of a new Fire Territory. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve Resolution 2019-R-08. Council Member Stonecipher seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote.

-Renewal of Resident Only Parking Permit – 401 West Brooks Ave. The Council was presented with a recommendation from the TRC Committee to deny the renewal of the Resident Only Parking Permit application for 401 W. Brooks Avenue, citing ample on-site parking and application was non-medical in nature. Council member Gilkey made a motion to accept the recommendation of the TRC Committee and deny application for resident only parking permit. Council Member Stonecipher seconded the motion and was carried by a 5-2 vote, with Council Member Hauber and Council Member Worrall voting NAY.

-Ordinance 2019-BUD-03 Transferring Funded Appropriations for Purchase of Police Vehicles. Funding for approved Police vehicles was divided between two funds. An error due to lack of explanation in reporting by the Federal Government resulted in COPS Grant funds being used incorrectly. As a result it is now necessary to modify the funding. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve Ordinance 2019-BUD-03. Council Member Hauber seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote.

**Adjournment...** There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, a motion was made to adjourn by Council Member Gilkey, seconded by Council Member Hunt, and carried by a 7-0 vote. The March 5, 2019 meeting of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
