

**MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE

**Discussion of Logo Development**

Representatives from Box Car came before the Council and presented to them several snapshots of possible logos for the Town. Discussion was held regarding the Logo not taking the place of the Town Seal. Further discussion was held and the consensus of the Council was they needed different options for a Logo with a more historical aspect. Box Car advised they would send out a questionnaire to obtain more specific ideas and data from Council Members and they would devise more options and send to them prior to another meeting. No further action was taken on this matter.

**Discussion of Portable Pumps for WWTP**

Utility Director Brittany Montgomery came before the Council to request the purchase of 2 portable pumps due to the existing pumps being aged and unreliable. Discussion was held regarding the ramifications of not having a reliable, working portable pump and the benefits of having new ones. Further discussion was held and it was the consensus of the Council to purchase the pumps.
