

**MINUTES OF THE March 26, 2019 JOINT WORK SESSION OF

A Work Session of the Redevelopment Commission and the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on March 26, 2019 at 6:32 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Commissioner A. D. Stonecipher and Council President Paul Fetter.

**Resoluiton 2019-R-06 Terminating the Town of Clarksville's participation in an Interlocal Agreement with City of Jeffersonville and Jeffersonville-Clarksville Flood Control (Cane Rune Pump Station)**... Discussion was held on terminating the Interlocal agreement with the City of Jeffersonville and the Jeffersonville-Clarksville Flood Control as they have failed to satisfy their contractual obligations under the agreement for the funding of repair or replacement of Flood Control's Cane Run Pumping Station.

A motion was made by Council Member Gilkey to table Resolution 2019-R-06 terminating the agreement for Cane Run Pump Station until the April 2, 2019 meeting of the Council, allowing City of Jeffersonville and Flood Control another chance to comply with the original obligations of the agreement, seconded by Commissioner Voignier and carried by 7/0 vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Voignier to approve Resolution 2019-R-06 terminating the agreement for Cane Run Pump Station, seconded by Commissioner Stonecipher carried by 3/1 vote with Commissioner Fetter abstaining, contingent on the Council vote on April 2, 2019.
