

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE
TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON FEBRUARY 1, 2016

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on February 1, 2016 at 8:14 P.M. in the Council Chambers of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Tim Hauber, John Gilkey, Paul Fetter, David Worrall, Jennifer Voignier, David Fisher and Aaron Stonecipher.

Request for Funding for Fiber Festival... Carol Smith, representing the Fiber Festival, came before the council to request funding. Ms. Smith advised this is the 6th year for the festival and expect this year to be bigger than the previous years. The festival is schedule for 4/30/16-5/1/16. Discussion was held and Ms. Smith was advised to bring her request to the next council meeting for a vote.

Petition for Sidewalks for Hallmark Heights Subdivision... John Bartlett came before the council to request sidewalks for the Hallmark Heights subdivision. Discussion was held and Project Coordinator Brittany Montgomery advised that sidewalks are a part of the redevelopment plan at the Park and that the Renaissance Academy is responsible for a portion of sidewalks as well. Mr. Bartlett was advised to keep in touch with Street Commissioner Cummings for progress and dates set for installing sidewalks.

Annual Support Contract with Stantec... Tom Clevidence presented a contract with Stantec for annual reporting purposes on the MS4 program. The amount of the contract is \$16,860.00. Council President Fetter advised this contract helps keep the town in compliance with all laws and rules regarding Stormwater Management and out of fining area. Mr. Clevidence was advised to bring this to the next council meeting for a vote.

Dropbox Proposal Submission from Infinite Solutions... Council Member Gilkey presented a quote from Infinite Solutions regarding using a Drop Box program for emails. Discussion was held and it was advised to bring to next council meeting for a vote.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, Council Member Gilkey made a motion to adjourn, Council Member Voignier seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote. The meeting was adjourned at 8:49 P.M.
