<u>Presentation of Insurance Renewal with Neace Lukens...</u> Representatives from Neace Lukens presented an introduction of insurance renewals. There were no changes but the insurance committee will need to another meeting and will bring back to council at a later date prior to June 1st for renewal. The summary plan document will need to be revised.

Request for Funding for ClarkFest 2016... Pam Seabolt came before the council to request funds for ClarkFest 2016. Ms. Seabolt was advised to bring to next meeting for a vote.

<u>Proposals for Westmount Drive Traffic Study...</u> Planning Director Sharon Wilson submitted a proposal from VS Engineering, who had the low bid of \$9750.00 for a traffic impact study at Westmount Drive and CR 311. Ms. Wilson was advised to bring to next meeting for a vote.

Request for additional firefighter... Chief Skaggs requested approval to add one additional firefighter, making the total 31 firefighters. Chief Skaggs was advised to bring to next council meeting for a vote.

Approval for Deer Run Subdivision Paving... Tom Clevidence made a request to the council to approve the paving for the Deer Run Subdivision and advised this was a time sensitive matter. Mr. Clevidence advised that MAC Construction came in with low bid of \$233,312.00. Council Member Stonecipher made a motion to approve paving of Deer Run. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

<u>Discussion on Storage Tow Lot...</u> Discussion was held and council agreed to have Chief Palmer move forward in obtaining information about opening a Town Lot in the future. No committee formed.

<u>Adjournment</u>... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, Council Member Gilkey made a motion to adjourn, Council Member Voignier seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote. The meeting was adjourned at 10:32 P.M.
