

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE
TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON JUNE 6, 2017

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on June 6, 2017 at 8:23 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council Vice President Jennifer Voignier who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: David Fisher, Tim Hauber, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Jennifer Voignier, and Aaron Stonecipher. Absent: Paul Fetter

Update of 2017 ClarkFest Plans... Kevin Harper came before the Council to provide an update on 2017 ClarkFest. The festival will be on Saturday 10/21/17 from 10-3 at Gateway Park off Eastern Blvd. Activities in the planning are Community Booths, Craft Booths, Food Vendors, DJ/Band, Inflatables and other kid friendly activities and games. There will also be a Car Show from 10 a.m. -3 p.m., the Parade will begin at 11:30 a.m., along with a 5k walk/run to kick things off at 8:00 a.m.

The Festival Committee is requesting the Town's endorsement, a \$15,000.00 donation, security presence on the festival grounds, Police, Fire & EMS available at the Festival, Car Show, & Parade, along with support from the Department of Public Works. The budgetary needs of the Festival are fees and permits, equipment rental, advertising and printing, activity and entertainment costs, and awards and prizes. Discussion was held and Mr. Harper was advised to come to the next Council meeting for his monetary request.

Request for Therapy Pig by Resident... Mary Smith came to the work session of the Council to request permission for the use of a therapy pig, as the Town's Codes and Ordinances do not allow farm animals within Town limits. Discussion was held regarding the medical use of the pig as therapy and the current Ordinance not allowing farm animals in Town. This matter was tabled until an update on the zoning ordinances could be completed.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, Council Member Worrall made a motion to adjourn, Council Member Hauber seconded the motion and was carried by a 6-0 vote. The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 P.M.
