

MINUTES OF MEETING OF
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON JULY 5, 2017

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on July 5, 2017 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council Vice President, Jennifer Voignier, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Tim Hauber, David Fisher, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Jennifer Voignier. Absent: Paul Fetter and Aaron Stonecipher.

Invocation: Pastor Juan Morales, Fuentes de Aguas Vivas Church, Eastern Blvd. Clarksville, IN.

Approval of Minutes: Council Member Fisher made a motion to approve the minutes of the 6/20/17 Regular Meeting, Work Session and Executive Session. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by a 5-0 vote.

Approval of Claims: Accounts payable registers presented for approval consisted of Town current claims in the amount of \$315,095.45, Town pre-approved claims issued through 07/05/2017 in the amount of \$660,863.19, Wastewater/Stormwater utility current claims in the amount of \$510,453.95, Wastewater/Stormwater utility prewritten claims in the amount of \$69,075.14 with an amendment by Town Manager Baity for a Wastewater refund. Wastewater Bonds in the amount of \$11,237.67, and payroll register for week ending 06/18/17 in the amount of \$359,312.89. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve claims registers presented. Council Member Hauber seconded the motion and was carried by a 5-0 vote.

Approval of Authorization to Submit an Application for the 2017 INDOT Community Crossing Grant Program... Town Manager Baity presented Council with a request to authorize the submission in the amount of \$1,000,000 (\$2,236,054 total cost) for the South Clark Blvd. improvements. Including the milling and resurfacing the street and replace drainage structures under Colgate Park and Clark Blvd., among other projects. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to accept the recommendation. Council Member Hauber seconded the motion and was carried by a 5-0 vote.

Council Comments:

-Council Member Tim Hauber wanted to thank everyone for their participation in the 4th of July Festival.

-Council Member John Gilkey said there was a record crowd of 250 attending the Independence Day Concert. He thanked Mike Mustain for photographing the event, **and for the Fire Department showing up when the fire alarm was accidentally pulled.**

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Gilkey, seconded by Council Member Hauber, and carried by unanimous vote, the July 5, 2017 meeting of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 7:14p.m.
