

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF  
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL  
HELD ON SEPTEMBER 20, 2016

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on September 20, 2016 at 8:29 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President, Paul Fetter, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber, David Fisher, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Jennifer Voignier, and Aaron Stonecipher.

**Amend Agreement with Sethi Development, LLC....** Redevelopment Director Dylan Fisher made a recommendation to the Council to revise the August 1<sup>st</sup> forgivable loan agreement with Sethi Development, LLC, to reflect a new agreement in the sum of \$80,000.00. Redevelopment Director also recommended the Town Council make a recommendation to the RCD to review the proposed project for possible assistance. A motion was made by Council Member Fisher, seconded by Council Member Worrall to accept the recommendation made by RD Fisher and passed unanimously with a 7-0 vote.

**Approval of 2016-S-07, an amendment to salary ordinance for department heads...** Council President Fetter presented salary ordinance 2016-S-07 for its second reading. Council Member Hauber made a motion to approve 2016-S-07. Council Member Voignier seconded the motion and was carried by a 5-0-2 vote, with council members Gilkey and Fisher abstaining.

**Adjournment...** There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Stonecipher, seconded by Council Member Voignier, and carried by unanimous vote, the September 20, 2016 special meeting of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 8:31 P.M.
