

**MINUTES OF MEETING OF

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on April 2, 2019 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter, who chaired the meeting.

-Appointment to Board of Zoning Appeals. Council Member Stonecipher recommended Deborah Ernstberger and made a motion to approve. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

-Suspension of Fees for Temporary Sign Permits on Commercial Property pending a new fee schedule scheduled to be presented at the April 16, 2019 meeting. A motion was made to

approve by Council Member Hauber. Council Member Worrall seconded the motion and it was carried by a 7/0 vote.
