MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON SEPTEMBER 4, 2018

A Work Session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on September 4, 2018 at 7:58 P.M. in the Executive Conference Room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter who chaired the meeting.

Presentation on Blackiston Mill Road Bridge by Jacobi, Toombs & Lanz, Inc.

Jorge Lanz of JTL, came before the Council and presented the Project Fact Sheet and presentation on the route options for the new bridge over Silver Creek on Blackiston Mill Road, linking Clarksville and New Albany. Mr. Lanz presented four route options in detail, including video with potential driving views. Discussion was held. No action was taken on this matter as it was intended to be an informational presentation and discussion and to provide a baseline for future discussion.

Presentation on new Public Works Facility by TEG Consulting

TEG Consulting presented design concepts for the new Public Works Facility to be constructed next to the Wastewater Facility on Hwy 62, including building locations and use. There was also discussion on constructing an access road from Hwy 62 to assist the local businesses and alleviate traffic in the nearby neighborhood. Potential cost was discussed briefly, with discussion on options for the property. No further action was taken at this time.

Presentation on new Police Tow Lot

Police Chief Palmer came before the Council to express the need for a Tow Lot for the Police Department. Chief Palmer elaborated on the potential use of the property selected for purchase, as well as staffing needs and potential income opportunities for the property. Chief Palmer requested permission to proceed with obtaining cost quotes and financing options. The general consensus of the Council Members was to proceed with obtaining more information on prices and financing. No further action was taken at this time
