

**MINUTES OF THE APRIL 2, 2019 JOINT WORK SESSION OF
THE REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION AND THE
CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL**

A Work Session of the Redevelopment Commission and the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on April 2, 2019 at 8:46 P.M. in the executive conference room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Commissioner A. D. Stonecipher and Council President Paul Fetter.

Discussion of Interlocal Agreement with Jeffersonville and Jeffersonville-Clarksville Flood Control... Jorge Lanz representing the Jeffersonville Flood Control came before the Commission and the Council expressing his concerns about terminating the Interlocal Agreement for the financing, and construction of a new flood control pump station #5 (Cane Run Pump Station). Mr. Lanz recommended extending more time before terminating the Interlocal Agreement. Following further discussion it was determined that a meeting be scheduled with all parties involved and to be set for April 18, 2019 or April 22, 2019 with the stipulation that the Interlocal Agreement be signed at the meeting.
