

A MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE  
TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON APRIL 16, 2019

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on April 16, 2019 at 8:12 P.M. in the Council Chambers of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Aaron Stonecipher, Jennifer Voignier and Jaime Hunt.

**Continued Discussion of Lewis & Clark Trail Expansion Event**

Lucas Green, property manager for the Falls of the Ohio State Park opened discussion on the celebration event for the expansion of the Lewis & Clark Trail. Potential activities were discussed, followed by discussion on potential funding avenues for the event. Community Members were tasked with contacting multiple agencies to assist in locating available funding for the event. Findings and further discussion was scheduled for the May 6, 2019 Work Session.

**Demonstration of Building & Zoning software**

Building Commissioner Rick Barr opened discussion on potential new software for the Building and Zoning office. A remote demonstration was presented by Brian Ondrake and Sam Chapin with Dude Solutions for the Council Members. It was determined that Council Members questions and concerns would be addressed as the software was developed and would be discussed further at a later date.

**Update of Matt Oakley Development**

Attorney Greg Fifer presented the results from the meeting with residents at the previous work session on April 2, 2019. They discussed connecting to the Town of Clarksville's Sewer System as a solution. After discussion, it was the general consensus of the Council Members to approve the request.

**Presentation of Teen Property Improvement Program**

Council Member Stonecipher has been approached by a Youth Group interested in providing property improvement services to those needing assistance in our community. They have an arrangement with the City of Jeffersonville who has donated \$10,000 to invest in their community and would like to extend into the Clarksville Community. It was determined there was more information needed and would be discussed at a future meeting.

**Adjournment.**... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Fetter, seconded by Council Member Gilkey, and carried by 7-0 vote, the April 16, 2019 work session of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 10:51 p.m.
