

A MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON MAY 6, 2019

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on May 6, 2019 at 8:58 P.M. in the Council Chambers of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Aaron Stonecipher, Jennifer Voignier and Jaime Hunt.

Update on School Resource Officer

Principal Winebrenner from Parkwood Elementary School, Interim Superintendent Mark Laughner and teachers were present to request a School Resource Officer, citing a significant influx of students with behavior issues. Chief Palmer provided information on the number of officers pulled from regular duties to answer calls from the school. He advised he will be dedicating an officer at the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year in an attempt to decrease the loss of Officers on the street.

Discussion on Imagery Update for GIS Software in 2020

Planning Director Arbal presented information on the Imagery Capture in Partnership with County Entities. The County is attempting to finalize all the participating partners, and draft an inter-local agreement that would require a signature from Clarksville. Further discussion to follow when the agreement is prepared.

Update on Matt Oakley development.

Discussion on the stalled development included potential action or litigation options, including a potential injunction that could provide temporary relief for nearby residents. Further discussion to follow with details on the options available.

Update on non-resident sewer project (County Line Rd)

Discussion about the responsibilities the Town of Clarksville has in that area. It was discussed and suggested the residents should contact the Town of Sellersburg to connect with their sewer system due to the area being annexed by Sellersburg.

Update on non-resident sewer project (County HWY 311)

Discussion about the responsibilities the Town of Clarksville has in that area. A meeting is still being planned with the developer and owner to continue discussion.

Discussion of Comprehensive Storm Sewer Plan

Discussion about a potential comprehensive plan for the entire town as the plan currently in use is from 2008. Discussion was held on cost which was considered unreasonable. Council Members suggested Director Montgomery and Commissioner Cummings conduct their own study to identify the greatest needs.

Discussion of Town Newsletter

Discussion about the next issue of the Town Newsletter and potential alternate or additional delivery methods including email. Also discussed was the potential content, and delivery increments of future publication.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Fetter, seconded by Council Member Gilkey, and carried by 7-0 vote, the May 6, 2019 work session of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 10:49 p.m.
