A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on MAY 21, 2019 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter, who chaired the meeting.

Recognitions:

Indiana Department of Natural Resources thanked all of the departments for their hard work and the success of the Lewis & Clark National Trail extension celebration.

Consent Agenda:

-Approval of the Minutes of Town Council Meeting Work Session and Executive Session held on May 2 and 6, 2019, approval of the Claims of Town Current & Pre-written, WW/SW Current & Pre-written. WW/SW bonds and Payroll. A motion was made by Council Member Gilkey to Approve. Council Member Hauber seconded the motion and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

Requests to Move Items from Consent Agenda:

Council Member Gilkey requested 2019-Z-04 and 2019-Z-05 be removed from the consent agenda and voted on with discussion. Request granted.

Council Member Hauber requested the Requests for Resident Only Parking Permits be removed from the consent agenda and voted on with discussion. Request granted.

New Business:

-Approval of Ordinance 2019-Z-04 Rezoning Property at 1026 North Clark. A motion was made by Council Member Gilkey to Approve. Council Member Hunt seconded the motion and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

- Approval of Ordinance 2019-Z-05 Amending Article IV, Division 157 – Accessory Uses and Structures of the Clarksville Zoning Ordinance. A motion was made by Council Member Gilkey to Approve. Council Member Worrall seconded the motion and it was carried by a 6-1 vote, Council Member Stonecipher voting Nay.

- Resolution 2019-R-19 Establishing the Gateway Crossing Economic Revitalization Area (ERA), allowing possible tax incentives to future developers pending future approval. A motion was made by Council Member Gilkey to Approve. Council Member Hauber seconded the motion and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

- Resolution 2019-R-20 Regarding Convention and Tourism Bureau Bonds, whereas the Tourism Bureau anticipates bonds being issued and the Town will be submitting an application to the Tourism Bureau for various place-making and quality of life projects in S. Clarksville. A motion was made by Council Member Hauber to Approve. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

-Requests for Resident Only Parking Permits. A motion was made by Council Member Voignier to Table. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and it was carried by a 6-1 vote, Council Member Stonecipher voting Nay.

- Resolution 2019-R-21 Approving Interlocal Agreement for Aerial Photography Services for GIS Mapping. A motion was made by Council Member Gilkey to Approve. Council Member Voignier seconded the motion and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, a motion was made to adjourn by Council Member Gilkey, seconded by Council Member Voignier, and carried by a 7-0 vote. The May 21, 2019 meeting of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 7:44 p.m.
