A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on July 2, 2019 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter, who chaired the meeting.

Recognitions:

Judge James Guilfoyle conducted the swearing in ceremony for new Police Officers, Dalton Fitzgerald and Andrew Archer.

Chief Palmer, along with Officer Matt Bauer and Chapo presented a Special Recognition Plaque to Dr. H.R. Gough for his donated services to Clarksville and all of Clark County. Dr. Gough thanked everyone for their appreciation.

Public Comments:

- Jeff Donayell, 1115 Marlowe Drive, Apt A4. Mr. Donayell came before the Council to see if a stop sign or speed bump could be placed between Blackiston Mill Road and Marlowe Court. Mr. Donayell advised there were no speed limit signs posted.
- Pastor Jim Moon, 1820 E. Park Place, Jeffersonville, IN. Mr. Moon came before the Council to request a \$30,000.00 donation from the Council to aid in the relocation of residents at America's Best Inn.
- Paul Stensrod, 2237 Birch Drive, Clarksville, IN. Mr. Stensrod came before the Council to advocate for the residents at America's Best Inn, relating some of their issues and their inability to obtain affordable housing.

-Approval of Ordinance 2019-G-13, an ordinance prescribing penalties for violations of Chapter 117 of the Clarksville Municipal Code. Council Member Hauber made a motion to approve. Council Member Hunt seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote. For the second reading, Council Member Hauber made a motion to approve. Council Member Hunt seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote. This will be effective after two publications.
