

MINUTES OF MEETING OF
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON JULY 16, 2019

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on July 16, 2019 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Aaron Stonecipher, Jennifer Voignier, Tim Hauber and Jaime Hunt.

Invocation: Pastor Jim Bullock, Colgate Baptist Church

Recognitions:

Manager Baity came before the Council to present to them two awards. One for The Lewis and Clark Trail Expansion YOUTUBE documentary, which will be archived in the State Library of Archives, and one for The Falls of the Ohio film that earned a first time ever Gold Medal Award.

Public Comments:

- Barb Anderson, 827 Maple Street, Jeffersonville, IN. Ms. Anderson came before the Council to request funds for the relocation services necessary for the residents of America's Best.

-Dennis Burke, 100 W. Lynnwood, Clarksville, IN. Mr. Burke came before the Council regarding the recent wastewater policies enacted. Mr. Burke advised not enough information was given to residents regarding pool water back wash and doing away with the summer sprinkling discount. Council President Fetter referred Mr. Burke to speak with Brittany Montgomery regarding these issues and what his options are.

-Pastor Jim Moon, 1818 Wesley Court, Jeffersonville, IN. Pastor Moon came before the Council on behalf of the residents at America's Best Inn. Council President Fetter advised there would be a detailed discussion at the work session and asked all interested parties to stay for that meeting.

*Council Member Hauber made a motion to suspend the no vote rule at the work session so that a prompt decision could be made regarding the request for allocation of funds. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

-Approval of a General Services Agreement with Redwing Ecological Services.

Council Member Stonecipher made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Council Member Hunt seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

New Business:

-Approval of Ordinance 2019-BUD-06, a Transfer Ordinance of funds between major budget classifications. For the first reading, a motion was made by Council Member Gilkey to Approve.

Council Member Hauber seconded the motion and it was carried by a 7-0 vote. For the second reading, a motion was made by Council Member Gilkey to Approve. Council Member Hauber seconded the motion and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

-Approval of Agreement with Indiana American Water for Utility Extension at 1410 S. Clark Blvd. Council Member Hauber made a motion to approve agreement. Council Member Voignier seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

-Approval of Ordinance 2019-Z-06, an ordinance amending the Gateway Crossing Planned Unit Development. Council Member Voignier made a motion to approve. Council Member Worrall seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote. Plan Commission Recommendation attached to ordinance.

-Approval of Agreement regarding the Annexation and Zoning of Darrell Raymond Killen Revocable Living Trust. Council Member Voignier made a motion to approve agreement. Discussion was held. Council Member Stonecipher voiced the concerns of his constituents regarding inadequate greenspace and traffic congestion. Council Member Voignier advised she had spoken with County Commissioner Coffman and he advised the County would help with adding a turn lane in that area. Council Member Hunt seconded the motion and the motion passed with a 5-1-1 vote, with Council Member Stonecipher voting nay and Council Member Gilkey abstaining.
