

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN
COUNCIL HELD ON OCTOBER 22, 2019

A special meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on October 22, 2019 at 6:00 P.M. in the Training Room of the Clarksville Police Department by Council President Paul Fetter who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Jennifer Voignier and Aaron Stonecipher. Absent: Jaime Hunt

Presentation and Discussion of Budget as it relates to the Police Department

Council President Fetter started the meeting off by reading a statement that addressed the work of the previous Council and the current Council increasing the manpower in the Police Department, an 18% increase in pay over the last 8 years, supportive of the change to 12-hour shifts, and the fact that Officers are armed with the best equipment and vehicles.

Manager Baity addressed the Council and gave a brief overview of General Fund Budget expenditures, as well as the LOIT Public Safety Fund, and the Insurance Fund. (Documents are available for review at the Office of the Clerk Treasurer). Discussion was held regarding the specific allowable expenses of each of those funds and how they contribute to the funding of the Police Department.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Gilkey, seconded by Council Member Hauber, and carried by 6-0 vote, the October 22, 2019 special meeting of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 6:48 p.m.
