

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN
COUNCIL HELD ON NOVEMBER 19, 2019

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on November 19, 2019 at 8:15 P.M. in the Executive Conference Room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Jaimean Hunt, Jennifer Voignier and Aaron Stonecipher.

Presentation of 2020 Census Preparation

Rebecca Valois came before the Council to share with them a Community Partnership and Engagement Program. The presentation gave an overview of the steps and the process of the 2020 Census. Ms. Valois advised help will be needed from the Town of Clarksville to ensure that the Census is getting accurate numbers, as this effects Federally aided funds. Ms. Valois is asking for volunteers to help spread the word so that everyone participates in the Census.

Discussion of Proposed Updates to Wastewater Ordinance

Utility Director Brittany Montgomery came before the Council to present proposed changes to the Wastewater Ordinance and Adjustment Policy. Discussion was held regarding changing billing from 1000's of gallons to 100's of gallons, requirements for oil/water separators and grease interceptors with a reporting component with penalties, and the Design and Construction Portions of the Ordinance. Ms. Montgomery advised it's been almost 15 years since the last update to this ordinance and the current ordinance is not meeting the Town's needs. Further discussion was held regarding the adjustment policy regarding leak adjustments, water company errors and the suggestion of creating a Wastewater/Stormwater Appeals Committee. Ms. Montgomery is to present updated Ordinance at a future Council Meeting for approval.

Council Member Worrall made a request to the Council to ask for a \$2500.00 donation match to Clarksville Cares. The consensus of the Council is to approve the donation.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Gilkey, seconded by Council Member Voignier, and carried by 7-0 vote, the November 19, 2019 work session of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 9:33 p.m.
