

MINUTES OF A JOINT SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE
TOWN COUNCIL AND THE CLARKSVILLE REDEVELOPMENT
COMMISSION HELD ON DECEMBER 17, 2019

A joint session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on December 17, 2019 at 8:33 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Paul Fetter, who chaired the meeting and by Redevelopment President Aaron Stonecipher.

Council members present: Paul Fetter, Tim Hauber, John Gilkey, David Worrall, Jennifer Voignier and Aaron Stonecipher. Absent: Jaime Hunt

Redevelopment Commission members present: Aaron Stonecipher, Paul Fetter, Jennifer Voignier, John Gilkey and Bill Wilson. Absent: Bryan Wickens

Presentation of Brown Station Way Corridor Study by Clark Dietz Engineering

Representatives of Clark Dietz Engineering gave a presentation of the Brown Station Way Corridor Study, which evaluated BSW between Randolph Avenue and Silver Creek, with a goal of providing recommendations for improving safety, reducing speed, developing neighborhood and trail connectivity while balancing the needs of pedestrians, cyclists, and transit.

Topics presented included traffic growth, transit (TARC) considerations, accident history, speed and travel time, and originations and destinations.

Recommendations made included: reducing lanes from 4 to 2, keeping opposing traffic separated, L&C interchange will be converted to an at-grade signalized intersection, Randolph Avenue will remain signalized, single lane round-about at Carter Avenue and at Bowne Blvd, reducing speed limit to 35, close intersections of N. Clark Blvd, Leuthart Drive, Emery Crossing and the residential access West of Lewis and Clark, and relocate Clarksville PW facility to the new intersection with Carter Avenue.

Discussion was held. No action taken at this meeting.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council and Redevelopment Commission at this time, on a motion made by Council Member Voignier, seconded by Council Member Worrall, and carried by 6-0 vote, the December 17, 2019 joint session of the Clarksville Town Council and the Redevelopment Commission adjourned at 9:51 p.m.
