I verify that I have not received funding through this program in the past two years for any properties. I verify that I am not directly related (parent, sibling, or child) to any full-time Town of Clarksville employees, members of Town Council, or candidates running for Town Council. I understand I may have to pay necessary permit fees and, if awarded, will have to pay a \$100 application fee to Planning and Zoning to receive grant funding through this program.

Property Improvement Program – Required Exhibits/Documentation for Commercial Applicants

Exhibits required at time of application

Current and (where available) historic photos of the structure

3 sets of conceptual drawings of the proposed work, to scale

For signs – color rendering of the design, specifications as to size and how the sign will be attached to the building and where

For awnings – color, size, material and style of awning; where it will be placed, and how

For painting – color scheme for the overall facade

Exhibits required prior to execution of the agreement

Project schedule/timeline

At least two bids from qualified contractors for project elements over \$5,000; and three or more bids for project elements costing \$10,000 or more

For major building alterations – building and construction details, and signed and sealed engineering or architectural drawings as appropriate

Cost summary listing each component of your budget

Exhibits/requirements prior to starting work

Final approval from permitting departments

Evidence of building permits and, where needed, a Certificate of Appropriateness; Assurance that alterations to the building incorporate federal requirements, including the Americans with Disabilities Act

Exhibits/requirements for payment at project completion

Copy of all contracts

Copy of all invoices and evidence of payment

Final waivers of any liens

Final inspection and approval
