

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON MARCH 3, 2020

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on March 3, 2020 at 6:00 P.M. in the Executive Conference Room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Ryan Ramsey who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Ryan Ramsey, Tim Hauber, John Gilkey, Mike Mustain, Karen Henderson, and Jennifer Voignier. Council members absent: A.D. Stonecipher.

Presentation of Wastewater and Stormwater Study for Green Acres Neighborhood

Greg Miller of Heritage Engineering came before the Council and presented an overview of the Sanitary Sewer evaluation of the Green Acres neighborhood. From the inspections completed, Mr. Miller stated the significant findings were: sump pumps connected to the system, cracks and roots in pipes, undersized pipes and offset joints. Mr. Miller stated this adds strain and maintenance to the pump and wastewater collection system. Recommendations are as follows: develop a program or policy for disconnecting groundwater and surface water from the sanitary sewers, lateral replacements, and lining to reduce I&I, backflow preventers, man-hole lid inserts, pipe maintenance and replacement.

Mr. Miller directed focus to Bowne Blvd. and advised the lack of access to sanitary sewer lines running behind the homes is a concern and prioritizes the area as most in need of attention. Mr. Miller proposes installing new lines in front of the homes under the street and abandoning the existing lines. A potential estimate of \$1.7 million was presented for full project completion for that area. Discussion was held. No action taken at this meeting.

A draft report will be submitted in approximately a month, with the need to finalize and prioritize a 5 to 10 year improvement plan.

Adjournment... There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, the meeting was dismissed by Council President Ramsey, the March 3, 2020 work session of the Clarksville Town Council adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
