Council Member Gilkey made a motion to table Ordinance 2020-ST-05, changing intersection of Lombardy Drive and Potters Lane from a one-way stop to a three-way stop, for further discussion. Council Member Voignier seconded the motion and was carried by a 4-3 vote, with Council Members Ramsey, Hauber and Henderson voting NAY.
