

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN
COUNCIL HELD ON SEPTEMBER 15, 2020

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on September 15, 2020 at 8:20 P.M. the Executive Conference Room room of the Clarksville Municipal Building by Council President Ryan Ramsey, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Ryan Ramsey, Tim Hauber, Mike Mustain, Jennifer Voignier, Aaron Stonecipher, Karen Henderson and John Gilkey.

Update on the Ambulance Contract for the County

Chief Skaggs came before the Council and advised there was a revised proposal for Ambulance service for the County that included an upgrade in the number of ambulances to six (6), and reduction in the price to \$700,000.00. Discussion was held and Council Member Stonecipher stated the County is responsible for ambulance service and feels the County should take care of obtaining a contract. No action taken on this matter.

Discussion of Renaming Woerner Avenue

Planning Director Jacob Arbital gave a brief overview of how Woerner Avenue came to be name, stating an eventual major landowner by the name of Frank Warner had built a grocery store and several houses in what was known as Warner Avenue Neighborhood. Staff is unaware of how the spelling of the street came to be. Other than Mr. Warner being active in civic affairs and local organizations and owning the neighborhood, there is no special designation attached to the name. Further discussion was held. Corey Hoehn stated that Main Street creates an immediate image of what could be. Other suggestions included York Avenue or something with water in the name. No action taken on this matter.

Discussion of Sidewalk Installation/Repair Policy

Public Works Commissioner Brad Cummings presented a Sidewalk Rating System Policy to the Council. The Policy includes inventory, analysis maps, charts and tables, and images which detail existing sidewalks within the Corporate Limits of Clarksville. In addition to this data, the GIS data will also be made available so that it may continually be updated as ongoing asset management and improvements are made. Further discussion was held regarding the inspections, criteria, and maintenance. No action taken on this matter.

Presentation of ESRI and Other Aerial Platforms

Planning Director Jacob Arbital came before the Council and gave a brief overview of the GIS (Geographic Information System) and Imagery. Planning Director Arbital explained how it's used as a foundation to build other systems and the layered spatial and analysis data sections of the program. No action was taken on this matter.
