The presentation consisted of Site Selection, Permanent Supporting House from a State perspective, the Development Team, (BWI, Clark Memorial Health, and Building & Impacting Communities), Management and Operation, and Community Impact. Discussion was held regarding the Development, and that it needs to be in an area where residents live and walk within the community in order for services to be available to those in need, such as Veterans, DV Victims and Single Parents, depending on the needs of the community. Serenity Akers is a Development of Permanent Housing with Services wrapped around them. Further discussion was held regarding Coordinated Entry and Security. No action was taken at this meeting.

Update on EMS Situation

Chief Skaggs advised the Commissioners have reached an agreement with New Chapel, including a 15 month agreement in the amount of \$700,000.00, providing the County with 6 ambulances.
