

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION
OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2020

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on November 2, 2020 at 7:38 P.M. the Executive Conference Room room of the Clarksville Municipal Building by Council President Ryan Ramsey, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Ryan Ramsey, Tim Hauber, Mike Mustain, Jennifer Voignier, Aaron Stonecipher, Karen Henderson and John Gilkey.

Presentation for EMS Service

Heartland Ambulance Service and Chief Skaggs presented information on EMS services, defining different levels of service including cost differences. There was also discussion on mutual aid with neighboring districts, and discussion of services offered along with the use of the trucks, followed by inquiries regarding the location of their home base, and potential for a town provided home base for a cost savings. Council Member Gilkey inquired about the condition of the Vaxter Avenue building and what renovation would be needed. No action taken at this meeting.

Discussion of Property/Casualty/Liability Insurance Renewal

Assured Partners presented renewal information on the town auto/property/liability insurance policy. There was discussion on factors related to an increase in premium, including a high instance of uninsured motorist claims. There was discussion on different companies offering estimates. Topics included coverages, costs, changes in property values, and insurability. Council Member Stonecipher inquired about Cyber Attacks and Ransomware, followed by discussion. No action taken at this meeting.

Discussion of Proposed Changes to On-Street Parking Regulations

Discussion was held on what should be allowed for parking on streets, and where it should be allowed. There was consideration given to how regulation changes would affect residents, especially the south end with narrower streets. There was also discussion regarding junk cars, emergency routes with access for large vehicles as large as fire trucks and garbage trucks. No action was taken at this meeting.
