

MINUTES OF MEETING OF  
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL  
HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2020

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on November 2, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Ryan Ramsey, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Ryan Ramsey, Tim Hauber, Mike Mustain, Karen Henderson, Jennifer Voignier, Aaron Stonecipher and John Gilkey.

**Consent Agenda:**

-Approval of the Town Current & Pre-written, WW/SW Current & Pre-written, Bonds, Grants and Payroll.

-Minutes of the Town Council Regular Meeting and Work Session, and Executive Session held on October 6, 2020.

Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Council Member Hauber seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

**-Resolution 2020-R-30 Renaming Woerner Avenue to Main Street and Establishing the List of Names for other New Streets within the South Clarksville Redevelopment Area**

Resolution 2020-R-30, a resolution proposing renaming Woerner Avenue to Main Street, and Establishing a list of names for other new streets with the South Clarksville Redevelopment Area, was presented to Council. Council Member Stonecipher proposed the addition of a woman's name, potentially Sacagawea. Council Member Stonecipher made a motion to amend with the addition of the name. Council Member Mustain seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote. Resolution 2020-R-30 proposed with the additional name, Council member Voignier made a motion to approve. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion, and was carried by unanimous vote

**-Approval of Contracts with HDR Engineering for Wastewater Design/Engineering Services**

The proposed contract with HDR Engineering for Wastewater Design/Engineering services was presented for review. Director Montgomery clarified a typographical error in the lump sum amount, stating the correct amount is \$224,820.00. Council Member Hauber asked for clarification on the type of road or trail, Director Montgomery indicated it could be classified as either without changing the design. It is a Wastewater/Stormwater access Road/Trail in the design. Council Member Stonecipher inquired about the selection of HDR Engineering, Director Montgomery indicated a strong working history with HDR Engineering, but that they also try to incorporate other vendors. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve with a correction in the amount of \$224,820.00. Council Member Mustain seconded the motion, and was carried by unanimous vote.

**-Approval of CDBG Grant for Clarksville Small Businesses**

The Community Development Block Grant funded through the Office of Community and Rural Affairs was presented with the first round list of eleven approved business names to receive a combined funding of \$87,500.00 to assist with continued business operations. Council Member Voignier made a motion to approve. Council Member Henderson seconded the motion, and was carried by unanimous vote.
