

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON DECEMBER 15, 2020

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on December 15, 2020 at 8:18 P.M. the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Ryan Ramsey, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Ryan Ramsey, Tim Hauber, Jennifer Voignier, Karen Henderson, Mike Mustain, and John Gilkey. Council Members present via teleconference: Aaron Stonecipher.

Discussion of Intersection Design: Brown Station Way and Carter Avenue

Manager Baity gave an overview of the best option regarding a Signalized Intersection at the new Public Works Facility that will maximize safety for vehicles leaving the facility site. The preferred option includes the following changes:

1. Closing the Bowne Blvd. "off ramp" from Brown Station's Way to N. Clark Blvd. (due to speed and the blind corner)
2. Locating the intersection at Carter Avenue rather than Leuthart Drive because of the connection to Carter Avenue to the North and the limited space available on Clark @ Leuthart Drive.
3. Reducing the number of intersection legs to improve safety and navigability and reduce delays.
4. Because of the residential nature of Clark Blvd. South of Carter, a cul-de-sac option is being considered at this location.
5. The North leg of Clark Blvd. @ Carter Avenue is proposed as a one-way northbound only leg.

Discussion was held. Staff is requesting direction to proceed and to take the next step toward design and traffic studies. The consensus of the Council is to move forward with studies and design and bring back to Council for consideration.
